

CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

1. The Guy Girl Thing....

- a. Guys stay away from the girls' cabin area and girls stay away from the guys cabin area.
- b. Guys and girls will sit separately during meetings.
- c. No physical show of affection.
- d. Guys' showers are on the "guys' cabin" side and the girls showers are on the "girls' cabin" side.
- e. Focus on what the Lord has for you this week and don't get distracted with "relationships."

2. Out of Bounds....

- a. No one is to use the bathrooms in the infirmary or A-frames.
- b. No one is to enter the castle except to use the side bathrooms.
- c. No one is to go to the swimming area or use canoes or boats except at designated times.
- d. No one is to enter the kitchen.
- e. No one is allowed in someone else's cabin.
- f. No one is to leave the campgrounds; if you have permission to go your parent must sign you out and in again with the nurse.
- f. No one is to leave the cabin after lights out except to quickly go to the bathroom.

3. Pitching in....

- a. *Anticipate* where you are supposed to be; try to get to places on time, consult the schedule, listen for announcements.
- b. Go to the bathroom *before* all meetings.
- c. Be quiet so *others* can listen; if you simply are incapable of paying attention then you must not disturb others.
- d. Toss your trash in appropriate places, pitch in by picking up trash around the camp; clean your own table and cabins.

4. A Christian Camp....

- a. Keep language clean, kind and helpful.
- b. No radios, walk-mans or other electronic distractions.
- c. Clothing should be modest (no two piece suits without a T-shirt, shorts not too short, clothes not too tight, no logos on T-shirts that are unwholesome)
- d. Listen and respond to staff members.
- e. No tobacco, alcohol, or controlled substances.
- e. During Chapel times the *guys* must take off their hats.
